SUBJECT CLASSIFICATIONS – as at September 2019

There are five sections:

B = "BUILDING/S" - shelved in lower Crawley Hall

E = "ENVIRONMENT" - shelved in West Room, beyond Serials Room

M = "MUSEUMS and HERITAGE SITES" – shelved in Serials Room

WCP = "Worshipful Company of Plumbers" – shelved in the Gridshell Artefacts Store, not the Library

DIS = Dissertations - shelved in the Serials Room - use B/E/M coding - see below

With the exception of "Serials" (journals, newsletters, magazines, etc), and most of the Worshipful Company of Plumbers collection of specialist books and trade catalogues, each publication is coded.

There are sub-sections within some categories (eg B05.2 = timber).

Generally within their categories and sub-sections publications are shelved in alphabetical order of author; some are by geographical area.

Be aware that:

- : offprints and small booklets are shelved in boxes or lever arch files
- : Weald & Downland Museum magazines are in M06 not with the Serials
